Bible Readings

Numbers 21:4-9

From Mount Hor they set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; but the people became impatient on the way. The people spoke against God and against Moses, 'Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we detest this miserable food.'

Then the Lord sent poisonous serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many Israelites died. The people came to Moses and said, 'We have sinned by speaking against the Lord and against you; pray to the Lord to take away the serpents from us.' So Moses prayed for the people. And the Lord said to Moses, 'Make a poisonous serpent, and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten shall look at it and live.' So Moses made a serpent of bronze, and put it upon a pole; and whenever a serpent bit someone, that person would look at the serpent of bronze and live.

John 3:14-21

And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.

'Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Those who believe in him are not condemned; but those who do not believe are condemned already, because they have not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the judgement, that the light has come into the world, and people loved darkness rather than light because their deeds were evil. For all who do evil hate the light and do not come to the light, so that their deeds may not be exposed. But those who do what is true come to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that their deeds have been done in God.'

Prayers of Intercession

Loving God, our heavenly Father,

Today especially we remember and thank you for all those who have mothered us, and for all that they have done for us: for those who gave birth to us, cared for us and helped us to grow in strength, wisdom and faith; for all who have had a mothering influence upon us and taught us ways of kindness and love.

We know that for some people this may be a difficult day, perhaps holding keenly felt loss and sadness, hurt, grief and maybe even anger. We pray that you will draw alongside those who are sad today, to comfort them and surround them with your compassion.

hear our prayer.

We pray for women and men who grieve because they are unable to have the children they so long to hold and love; for parents who grieve because, like Mary the mother of Jesus, they have had to see their child die too soon; for parents who grieve because they are cut off from their children by disappointment, anger or bitterness; for parents who are worried or afraid for their child's well-being or safety.

We ask you, heavenly Father, to bring healing, comfort, forgiveness and peace into the hearts and minds of hurting parents.

Lord, in your mercy

hear our prayer.

We pray for children who grieve because they have lost a parent through illness, accident or violence; for children whose parents have been unable to give them the love and care they need, so that they now live in families and homes which are not their own; for children who are still living in homes that are unsafe and with adults who cannot put the child's needs before their own; for children who through hardship and poverty are not being provided with an adequate diet or basic medical care.

We prayer for families living in unimaginable situations of conflict and bloodshed; for parents devastated because they are unable to find food, healthcare and safety for their children.

We ask you, heavenly Father, to bring love and security, courage and hope into the lives of suffering families today.

Lord, in your mercy

hear our prayer.

We ask you, heavenly Father, to bring healing and forgiveness into the lives of all those for whom today brings back painful memories of broken relationships and loss. Help us all to find in our brothers and sisters in Christ a loving family with whom we may show your love and tender care for all your hurting people.

Lord, in your mercy

hear our prayer.

We pray for our mother, the worldwide Church, seeking by her example to model the inclusive love and compassion which Jesus showed for all those in his community.

We give thanks for the Methodist Church and all its agencies, bringing light and hope to people struggling to survive and prosper, and for our local church with its various outreach and mission oriented activities, its committed and faithful members and inspirational leaders.

Loving God, trusting in your promise to hear us when we pray in faith, we ask you to bless all our relationships within the families of our homes, our church, our communities and our nation, so that through our lives your loving will for us may be done.






Lunch Club

Lunch Club will also meet on 28th March.








